Learning taking place in our classes this week & key messages!

EYFS	EYFS have loved the sunshine this week! We have replanted our sunflowers in the growing garden and made sure all the plants have been watered every day. We have continued learning about vegetables this week with a focus on keeping healthy. We have designed healthy food plates and discussed foods that we should eat every day to keep us fit and healthy. We have learnt about the difference between a fruit and a vegetable, some of us were quite surprised to find that a pea pod is actually a fruit! We have cooled down in the glade using the hammock to relax, had fun being creative with the water pump (and keeping cool in the water too!) and continued to wash, chop, 'cook', paint, print, and play with the wonderful veggies you have kindly donated. In maths the children have been learning to share fruit, coins, gems and vegetables fairly. In phonics the Kingfishers have been writing compound and polysyllabic words to go with our Monster Phonics story, The 3 Billy Goats. Please remember to apply suntan lotion before coming to school and to bring a suitable
	sunhat.
Key Stage 1	On Monday key stage one this week we had our amazing trip to Sheringham Park, this was the best trip I have ever been on! The children got to go on a bug hunt, make a green man out of clay, make natural sculptures and go pond dipping. The creatures that we found on the bug hunt and in the pond were fascinating and included newts, froglets, dragonfly larvae, leaches, water snails, water boatmen, violet ground beetles, woodlice, spiders and centipedes. The volunteers at Sheringham Park commented on how well behaved and engaged the children were. Thank you if you helped on the trip, we really appreciate your support. On Tuesday we started to plan a recount of our trip. We loved looking at the photos of the activities we did. When we got to Wednesday the adults in school were so impressed with the children's enthusiasm to write about what happened on our trip. The children worked hard to make their writing interesting and included adjectives, time words and noun phrases. In maths this week we have revisited time, using o'clock, half past, quarter past, quarter to and 5-minute intervals. We tried drawing our own clocks and putting the hands on a clock, it was tricky! Finally, we looked at some time word problems.
