Communication	We discussed the information that goes out and all the different way of finding out about what happens in school Forum suggested: More notice for events e.g. odd sock day/children in need An overview of what will be taught in core subjects over a half term – so maths, literacy and phonics
	Through discussion we realised that parents do not know who leads on each subject There is a lot of information on the website but we agreed that the website is more for people looking from outside the NIANs community. The NIANS community don't actually use the website
	We discussed that new parents aren't always sure what things are such as PATHs person and how to use Tapestry
Reading	We discussed reading in school and the idea that reading scheme books are kept in school and the children bring home just their book from the library or book shelf for reading with an adult. This is an idea that the staff have been thinking about. The Forum raised not understanding the colour coding and some families having a message on Tapestry and not others. This causes confusion
Zoom Bedtime story	We discussed if families would like a bedtime zoom once a week by a staff member Forum were positive about this idea
