





We will explore these celebrations through stories, art, visits to the local church and listening to and performing songs.	With the colder temperatures, we will be exploring the cold and ice. We are thinking about people who help us...at home, at school and in our community. We will learn about the emergency services and get to meet some of the important people who work there. We will train to be fire fighters in our fire academy, solve the crime in our role as police officers and learn how to keep safe and prevent accidents.	We are learning about why worms are so important through creating our own wormeries! We will also learn about a pond habitat and the creatures that live there. We will visit our local pond to gather more information and record through photographs and drawings. We will also learn about the life cycle of a frog!	We are learning about minibeasts. We will collect and observe the minibeasts living in our garden. We will learn about the life cycle of a butterfly and research spiders in more detail. We will also visit Bugs UK where we will be able to look at minibeasts found all over the world and even handle some of them!
