## As a school

We will do our best to:

- Support your child's wellbeing and safety by providing a safe, supportive and caring environment.

## Parents/carers

I will do my best to:

- > Make sure my child attends school regularly and on time.
- I will notify the school if my child will be absent before the start of the school day.
- Make sure my child is dressed in the correct uniform and P.E. kit.
- Support the school to make sure my child maintains a consistently high standard of behaviour.
- > Encourage my child to try their best so they can reach their full potential.
- Communicate to the school any concerns that I have about my child that may affect their behaviour in school or ability to learn.

- > Make sure communication with the school is respectful, and that I make every reasonable effort to address my communications to the appropriate member of staff.
- > To support our e-safety curriculum and monitor their child's use of technology at home.
- > Understand that I should communicate with staff during core school hours, and although they may respond at times outside of those hours, I can't always expect this will be the case.
- > Read and follow the school's policies.
- Treat all members of the school community with care and respect.
- > Engage in parent meetings and work together with the school in order to achieve the best outcomes for my child.
- > Read all communications sent home by the school and respond where necessary.
- > Encourage my child to read regularly, complete any home learning tasks and talk about their learning with them.

I will do my best to:

- > Arrive at school on time and ready to learn.
- Try my best to do my work and ask for help if I need it.
- > Wear the correct school uniform and PE kit.
- > Bring everything I need for school each day such as my reading book.
- > Be friendly, respectful and caring towards other children and adults both inside and outside of school.
- Listen to instructions from the adults at school and keep our school values.
- Look after the school equipment and be respectful of the school environment.
